This multi-method project aims to better understand behavioral health disparities among racial/ethnic minority and women veterans (n = 2,000), who make up a growing proportion of the veteran population but for which few theoretically informed, longitudinal studies exist. Using qualitative interviews, repeated longitudinal assessments, and innovative machine learning methods, we will test a comprehensive model of individual and environmental factors contributing to behavioral health symptoms, attitudes towards care, and actual care receipt among a large and diverse sample of veterans recruited outside of VA settings.
