He is a physician-epidemiologist, and biostatistician whose research interests are twofold. *First*, his substantive research focuses on developing and testing interventions to improve access and adherence to HIV treatment among adolescents in low-income settings. *Second*, he is a research methodologist interested in applying advanced methodological, statistical, and machine learning techniques in establishing intervention efficacy in studies with longitudinal and clustered data.
